

Policies

- Provide passes to use computers; offered book club at Emergency Cold Shelter; offer Housing Packets for community.
- Purchase cards only-no temporary cards; 30 min. guest pass @ one/day
- We require proof of a local mailing address so some seasonals can get a card, we honor and issue the Colorado card, and we offer a guest card for 25.00 a year
- We have a \$10 fee for a guest card. Good for one year.
- We have temp cards. No fees associated
- Computer use: Guest pass 91/day) with photo ID. Visitor cards for 3 months with \$50 deposit
- Temporary pass issued with out-of-state ID
- We have temporary, internet only library cards that are good for one month and cost \$2. We have a transitional card that is good for 6 months that costs \$15 and allows patrons access to books and internet.
- Guest pass is one hour per day
- In house and wifi usage all free.
- wifi free
- no fee for wi-fi use; can be accessed outdoors after hours
- guest past with 1 hour plus an additional hour if needed, free wifi
- Free wifi at all of our branches.
- Community Borrowers Card - all NC residents are eligible and seasonal residents too
- Yes, internet guest passes. Fine to use wifi after hours

- Temp cards - free - same privileges
- Children must have an over 16 adult with them if they are under 8. Deal with the ppl who don't follow policy on case by case as we can.

- We have deposit patron cards. \$20 an item with return of deposit with return of item
- We tend to offer most kids programs as drop in...no registration, but require emergency contact for most kid programs where parents presence is not required....

- Rather than sending cell phone users outdoors, I had a patron suggest we build an old-fashioned "Telephone Booth!"

- only can use cell phones at computers if doing business for very short time - other patrons give stink eye
- Cell phone use ok as long as short and quiet. We do provide public phone
