Radical Cataloging

• "...refers to addressing the root—systemic, or structural—issues behind social problems. Radical cataloging, in this way, is not necessarily an attempt to do away with or subvert cataloging altogether, but is rather intended to address the root issues that can make access to information problematic."

1910-1914	"Aliens" first appeared in LC
1980	"Aliens, illegal" was established
1993	Revised to "illegal aliens"
2010	Race Forward, The Center for Racial Justice Innovation
2013	Melissa Padilla at Dartmouth College
Jan 2016	ALA Council adopts resolution on replacement
Mar 2016	LC announces resolution for discontinuation
Jun 2016	House of Representatives votes to continue using SH
Jul 2016	SAC's working group finalizes recommendations for changes
Jun 2017 to present	No decision as of yet by LC




Still to do
